Rapha House is an organization that rescues children from human trafficking. Their headquarters is in Joplin, Missouri, but they work safe houses in Cambodia, Thailand, and Haiti.

These young girls and children are given a safe place to stay, healthcare, counseling, education, vocational training, access to social work and legal advocacy, and the gospel message of Jesus along with teachings on how to live for Him.

Rapha is a Hebrew word which means "healing," and healing is the heartbeat of Rapha House.

Proverbs For the Bulletins

Each one of us is responsible for our own actions. For our own lives. Proverbs help us make good decisions about life. Teach the Proverbs to your kids and grandkids highlighting one verse each in chapter (1-10).

Teach the following lessons about life:

I) Proverbs 1:10, “My son, if sinners entice you, do not give in to them.”

Teach: What to do if they are enticed to sin . . . RUN!

Entice = to harmonize with them. Sin = do they know what “sin” is?

I Timothy 5:22, “Do not share in the sins of others”

Proverbs 22:5, “In the path of the wicked lie thorns and snares, but he who guards his soul stays far from them.”

RUN from them, for YOU are responsible for your own actions. However, society continues to teach the opposite (Tom Brady).

Teach: Proverbs 1:10, “. . . If sinners entice you, do not give in to them.” RUN!

II) Proverbs 2:6, “For the Lord gives wisdom, and from His mouth comes knowledge and understanding.”

Teach: There are two choices in life that you can make:

1. Read God’s Word and pray for wisdom and understanding about life.
2. You can “learn” from the school of hard knocks.

The world says, “Experience is the best teacher.” Why then do we have so many repeat offenders going back to prison? Why do we have all those movie stars being married four times? When does the learning take place?

Teach: God’s Word gives wisdom and understanding about life.

III) Proverbs 3:3, “Let love and faithfulness never leave you; bind them around your neck, write them on the tablet of your heart.”

“Let love and faithfulness never leave you” literally means giving permission for love and faithfulness to always be a part of your life - to never let them leave.

Teach: Keep love and faithfulness there:

1. Bind them around your neck
2. Write them on the tablet of your heart.

IV) Proverbs 4:5, “Get wisdom, get understanding; do not forget my words or swerve from them.” Literally means YOU get wisdom. YOU get understanding.

Teach: Where do they come from? They come from God’s Word.

Teach: Don’t swerve from them. When driving a car you don’t want to swerve right or left, but keep going straight.

- V) Proverbs 5:21, “For a man’s ways are in full view of the Lord, and He examines all his paths.”
Teach: The Lord sees everything we do. We are to examine all the paths we take in life.
Idea: Look before you leap.
- VI) Proverbs 6:22, “When you walk, they will guide you; when you sleep, they will watch over you; when you awake, they will speak to you.” What is the “they” that guides you, watches over you, and speaks to you?
 Proverbs 6:20, “Your father’s commands ” and “Your mother’s teaching.”
 So, Dad and mom (and grandpa and grandma), teach God’s Word so that:
1. When your kids are weak, God’s Word will guide them.
 2. When your kids sleep, God’s Word will watch over them.
 3. When your kids awaken, God’s Word will speak to them.
- Deuteronomy 6:4-9, _____
- VII) Proverbs 7:1-2, “My son, keep my words and store up my commands within you. Keep my commands and you will live; guard my teachings as the apple of your eye.”
Teach: When you learn and remember God’s Word and guard it like you guard your eyes, then you will really live - life will be good.
 Galatians 5:22-23, there will be _____; and that is really living!
- VIII) Proverbs 8:13, “To fear the Lord is to hate evil; I hate pride and arrogance, evil behavior and perverse speech.”
Teach: Fear of the Lord means we hate evil, pride, arrogance, evil behavior, and perverse speech.
Teach: Christians don’t use bad words; we don’t act that way.
- IX) Proverbs 9:10, “The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, and knowledge of the Holy One is understanding.”
Teach: Fearing the Lord is the beginning of wisdom. It is the start of wisdom. So, without fearing the Lord - don’t even begin to have wisdom.
- IX) “And knowledge of the Holy One” = Bible reading and study.
 It is understanding. So, without reading the Bible, there is no understanding about life.
- X) Proverbs 10:4, “Lazy hands make a man poor, but diligent hands bring wealth.”
Teach: The American dream is from God’s Word. If you work hard, you can achieve in this life (financially).

Those are the verses I have chosen from each chapter (1-10). You might choose others. Just teach Proverbs so that your kids and grandkids will be ready to face the world.
